# Introduction

The Georgia Mountains Regional Commission (GMRC) is soliciting qualifications and price proposals from vendors to replace and install in-house server hardware and software. Existing data and software located on existing server must be migrated to replacement server. Project site is located at 1310 W Ridge Road, Gainesville, Georgia.

The selected vendors main office must be located within the GMRC's thirteen county region (Banks, Dawson, Forsyth, Franklin, Habersham, Hall, Hart, Lumpkin, Rabun, Stephens, Towns, Union, and White)

# Statement of Work/Hardware and Software Specifications

Existing server hardware is over six years old. Antiquated operating software exists and is no longer supported. This server also houses the Exchange Server whereby all agency emails travel through. We have numerous external drives to support in-house backup.

Replacement of the hardware and software is necessary and must be completed within 30 days of award. All software (other than operating software) and data housed on existing server must be migrated to new equipment. In-house users, administrator and email must be setup. Proposals must include labor quotation for the above-mentioned setup and migration.
