Youth Eligibility

Youth must ...

- Be between ages 16-24
- Be a resident of one of the following counties:
Banks, Dawson, Forsyth, Franklin, Habersham, Hall, Hart, Lumpkin, Rabun, Stephens, Towns, Union, and White
- Be withdrawn from High School, or not currently attending, a Credit Recovery Program
- Have at least 15 Credits

Additional Eligibility

- Is subject to the juvenile or adult justice system
- Homeless
- A runaway, in foster care or has aged out of the foster care system, a child eligible for assistance under section 477 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 677), or in an out-of-home placement
- Is pregnant or parenting
- Has a documented disability
- A recipient of a secondary school diploma or its recognized equivalent **who is a low-income individual and is—**
 - (aa) basic skills deficient; or
 - (bb) an English language learner
- A **low-income** individual who requires additional assistance to enter or complete an educational program or to secure or hold employment
 - Older youth (19 -24 years) who has a history of difficulty holding steady employment. (Steady employment is 30 hours per week for 6 months with the same employer.)
 - Resides in a non-traditional family setting: Being raised by a legal guardian or non-parent responsible for youth’s care
 - Parent is currently in jail or prison or has been in jail or prison for a minimum of six months in the last year.
